# ROSENTHAL HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION

### Benefits

- The Homeowners Association will provide long term maintenance for the Rosenthal Community.
- The Homeowners Association will preserve and enhance the appearance of the Rosenthal Community including items such as, but not limited to:
- Wood screen fence and masonry columns on major roadways and walkways, sound attenuation fencing and masonry columns along commuter arterial roadways, ornamental steel fence and masonry columns along green corridors, parks and storm water management facilities.
- Masonry entrance features with lighting and landscape treatment.
  Lighted entrance plazas to parks and enhanced stormwater
- management.
- $\circ$   $\quad$  Landscaping, stream courses, fountains and bridge.
- Enhanced landscaping and maintenance throughout the community.
- $\circ$   $\quad$  Additional facilities may be included as the development advances.
- The intention of the Homeowners Association is to go beyond the maintenance provided by the City in an attempt to uphold the aesthetic standard for the Community.
- The Homeowners Association provides immediate value to its members by maintaining and adding unique amenity elements to the Community that would not otherwise be present within the Community due to their unique nature.

The adjacent map illustrates the facilities which will be maintained by the Homeowners Association.

#### Home Owner Obligations

- A Rent Charge Encumbrance is registered on the title of every singlefamily lot and multi-family unit ensuring that all property owners are obligated to the Rosenthal Homeowners Association for the long term maintenance of the Community.
- Fees will be determined by the Homeowners' Association for single family and multi-family. Multi-family will contribute at a lesser rate than single family homes.
- Each home owner will have voting rights.
- The developer will work together with an informal advisory group of Rosenthal Community property owners to plan for the initiation of the association prior to substantial completion.
- An annual budget will be set by the Homeowners Association whom will determine the fees charged. Typical single-family home owner fees range between \$100 to \$200 per year.
